Pinacate Middle School campus utilized concrete masonry unit materials for interior and exterior locations. The entire campus is finished with masonry providing a durable exterior finish that can withstand the middle school environment.

The Academic Core Building design used 8x8x16 and 12x8x16 precision and burnished concrete masonry units in a running bond pattern, using units in gray, glacier white, and slate colors. The mixture of colors and textures arranged in strong horizontal bands creates visual character visually minimizing the mass of the building.

Two impressive masonry columns at each entrance of the building, in combination with a metal roof, provides the perfect balance to create an extraordinary building with programmatic adaptability. This new facility plays an important role in both the growth of Pinacate Middle School and provides an educational environment that is safe and secure for students and staff.
