Banc of California Stadium is a soccer-specific stadium in the Exposition Park neighborhood of Los Angeles. It is the home of Major League Soccer's Los Angeles Football Club (LAFC). Constructed on the site of the former Los Angeles Memorial Sports Arena, it is located next to the Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum.

Selection of Concrete Masonry Units (CMU) met the needs of the project providing durability, thermal mass and acoustic performance.

The stack pattern lines of burnished CMU's in white and black colors and the combination of an exposed structure, long-span cantilevers and an aluminum roof clad, helped the design team to create a state-of-the-art soccer stadium.

In addition to such a unique combination of materials, the stadium, which was designed within a high seismic region, earned a LEED® Silver rating.
