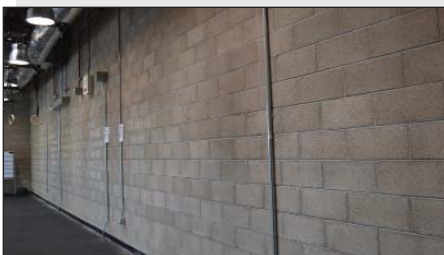
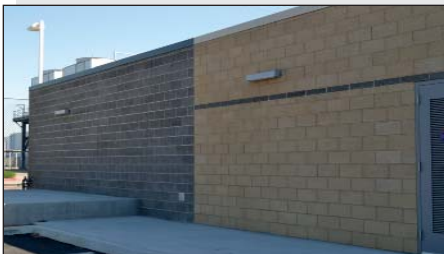

A new Gymnasium and Aquatic Complex at Wiseburn High School is located in the small town of El Segundo, adjacent to Los Angeles International Airport.

The use of masonry is an excellent example of the architectural freedom and design creativity. The intriguing projected block pattern was structurally challenging and quite unique, since it used left and right units required for the architectural pattern, providing an attractive building to be enjoyed by the students and visitors.

As part of the design, the building incorporates multicolor precision units with an accent band to contrast the architectural pattern and to complement the entryway glass panels.

The prominent character and identity of the facility is a magnetic focal point for the practice of sports in the Wiseburn Unified School District.
