Ventura County Fire Station No. 35 serves as the flagship for the Ventura County Fire Department, replacing an outdated single story concrete masonry unit (CMU) fire station.

Designed as an Essential Services Facility, the building is constructed to the highest standards to allow for continued operation under adverse conditions. The fire station is the center of life for those on-duty by providing living, sleeping and working spaces for nine firefighters, which also includes space for 3 fire vehicles.

Influenced by its immediate surroundings and broken into two-story building mass, the station used precision, honed, and polished block to create an interesting and functional spaces that defined areas of importance.

The combination of CMU and other materials offer structural integrity, durability, and functionality to this building that will serve the community for many years to come.
