The new two-story, three wing classroom buildings at Temple City High School displays a high level of design and construction quality.

Extensive use of both brick and Concrete Masonry Units (CMU) provides artistic character to complement the function of the complex. Recessed horizontal brick bands provide a unique architectural appearance to the complex, while burnished and split face CMU in stack bond adds distinctive personality and blends well with the established brick campus.
