The three-story Vista Grande Dining Pavilion houses seven new dining venues and a neighborhood market in an energy-efficient building. This facility was built to help create an environment of community and interaction with large, comfortable seating areas, outdoor fireplaces and game tables.

Concrete masonry units (CMUs) were a natural material solution to blend into the hill slope and are present throughout the campus in both buildings and retaining walls. Brick veneer was also worked into the scheme to tie into the existing brick buildings on campus.

The combination of CMUs and brick provide the durability, sustainability, and cleanability a dining pavilion requires. Additionally, the rich textures and colors of the CMUs and brick complement the aesthetics and architectural character of the university campus.

Vista Grande Dining Pavilion has been awarded LEED® Gold certification due to its resource-efficient design and sustainable materials.

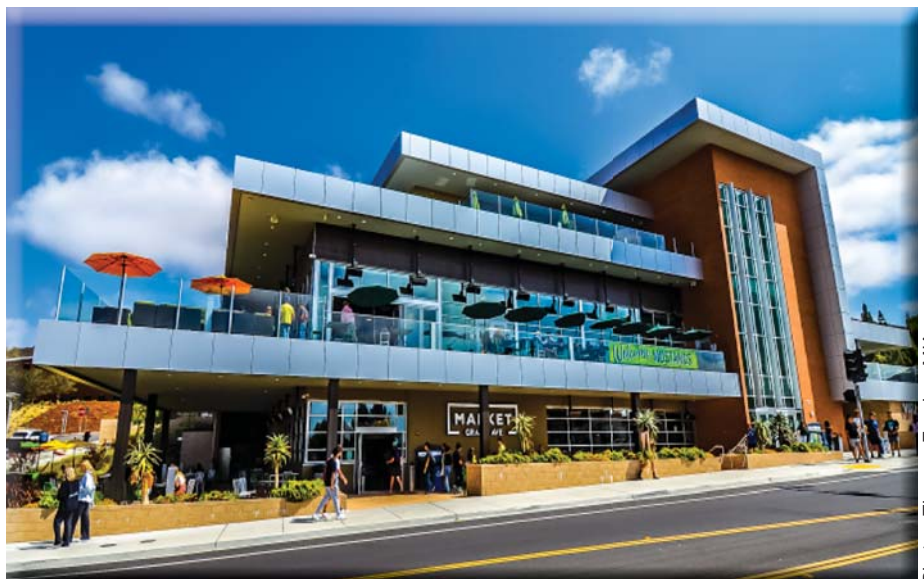
