The South Region High School #9 is an excellent example of the architectural freedom and design creativity offered by masonry. The intriguing folding line wall on several of the buildings was structurally challenging and quite unique, providing an attractive street-front building for the students and public to enjoy.

Inspired by the nearby Los Angeles River and nature, beautiful green toned load-bearing concrete masonry, with a mixture of gray and tan split face and precision projected CMU were used in building the High School.

Concrete masonry units were the dominant construction material due to durability, sustainability, ease of maintenance and cost effectiveness. Masonry offered the school a locally produced, high quality material capable of withstanding the wear and tear of students.
